



 Implementation and Post-funding Stage: Individual consultations, support by professional implementation team, advisory and mentoring services, project monitoring and regular Business Network Meetings




- For idea generation: Disadvantaged groups or individuals aged 18 or above with no bankruptcy order or proceedings during the application


